THE EXPERIENCE

Travelers begin their three-day Italian tour with an overnight stay at Il Salviatino (www.salviatino.com), a meticulously hand-restored 15th century villa in the rolling hills of Tuscany, overlooking the pulsing city of Florence.

The next morning, a Red Travel tour director and expert Ferrari driver introduces guests to the world of Ferrari, preparing them for the drive of a lifetime through the Tuscan countryside and into the Veneto region.

After an adrenaline-filled ride to the romantic, ancient town of Verona, guests check-in to Palazzo Victoria, a centrally located gem that seamlessly blends romantic Italian history with modernity.

Day 1

Welcome to Florence, cradle of the Renaissance

Day 2

Florence to Verona, through world-famous mille miglia passes and halt in Maranello, Ferrari's hometown

Route: Florence Mille Miglia passes (Futa & Raticosa) Maranello Verona

Morning

Meeting with your Red Travel Tour Director and welcome coffee, followed by a dedicated Ferrari briefing, with your car scenically displayed in a reserved area. The Tour Director, an expert Ferrari driver, will introduce our guests to the world of Ferrari; clarify the finer details of the controls, explain the differences between the various models (Ferrari 488 Spider, Ferrari California T, Ferrari 458 Speciale, Ferrari 458 Spider) and the engines (8-cylinder and new 8-cylinder turbo) and most importantly, give guidance on how to handle the F1 paddle-gear shifting behind the steering wheel.

All luggage will be transported separately.

During the whole journey, the Ferrari and the Tour Director's car will be constantly in touch by mobile radio system.


Departure by Ferrari for Maranello

Today's itinerary will include stops in some beautiful locations, among them the Mugello area, world-famous for the Mugello circuit, which hosts the Moto GP Grand Prix of Italy, as well as several car races. Whilst driving, our guests will be able to enjoy outstanding views of mediaeval villages and beautiful natural landscape that offer an overwhelming feast for the eyes. Guests will also be passing by the Passo della Futa, well-known as an important stage of the famous Mille Miglia race that took place in Italy in the 50's.

En route, halt at Passo della Raticosa for a coffee.

- Taking its legendary fame from the time of the Mille Miglia race, the Futa and Raticosa passes are the kind of roads you dream of if you get behind the wheel of a Ferrari.
- During the tour, several halts will allow drivers and passengers to swap seats, if they wish to.
- En route. visit to a traditional balsamic vinegar producer, Villa San Donnino, followed by a balsamic vinegar tasting.
- Arrival in Maranello and visits to the Ferrari Museum and the Ferrari store.

Lunch in Maranello - Restaurant suggestion: Il Cavallino, in front of the Ferrari factory.
